Equivalent Expressions

Combining Like Terms



Terms are separated by + or – signs in an expression.

Like terms may be combined according to the sign that separates them.

Constants are terms without a variable (digit alone) that may also be combined.

example: $7w + 4 + w + y + 2$

$7w + w = 8w$
 $4 + 2 = 6$
 $y = y$

$8w + 6 + y$
