### About your spelling words

Each of this week's words uses another of the many forms of the absorbed prefix *ad-*, meaning *to; toward*.

Although *ad-* has many forms, it is distinct from other common prefixes like *ab-* (*from; away; off*) and *a-* (most commonly *not; in or into; on; at*). Meaning and spelling can help you determine which prefix is being used, and vice versa.

- Say each word aloud. Write the number of syllables next to it.
- Which words have the fewest syllables? Is it possible to have an *ad-* word with only one syllable?
