## Two Kinds of Verbs

An **action verb** tells what the subject of the sentence is doing.

**examples:** jumped, walking, drinking, goes  
Marla goes to the magic show.

A **linking verb** connects the subject to a noun or adjective in the predicate.

**examples:** am, is, are, was, were  
Chloe and Ryan were the assistants at the magic show.
