Active and Passive Voice

There are two different ways to describe action.

subject

Active Voice

The subject of the sentence **performs** an action. The action is done by the subject.

Many active voice sentences follow a Subject + Verb + Direct Object pattern.

example: The weeds strangled the wilting flowers.

verb



Dy panent

example: The wilting flowers were strangled by the weeds.

subject verb

prepositional phrase

direct object

Both active and passive voice can be written in any tense.

_		Past	Present	Future
	Active	Mom tilled the soil.	Dad is planting new sprouts.	We will grow tulips.
	Passive	The soil was tilled by Mom.	New sprouts are being planted by Dad.	Tulips will be grown by us.

Active voice usually sounds more engaging to readers.

Most writing should avoid passive voice.
