Two Subjects and Two Predicates

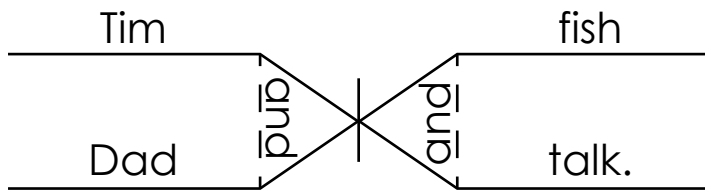
Some sentences have two simple subjects and two simple predicates.

example: **Tim and Dad fish and talk.**

Tim and **Dad** are simple subjects.

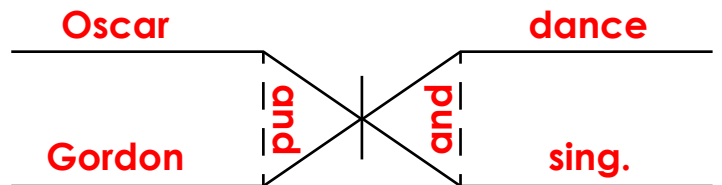
Fish and **talk** are simple predicates.

Here's how you make a diagram of a sentence that has two simple subjects and two simple predicates:

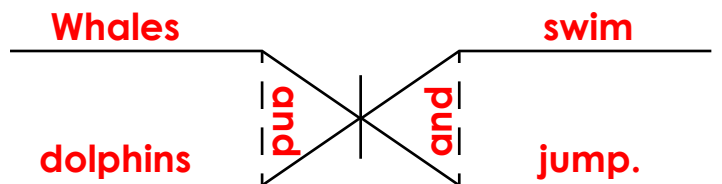


Circle the nouns in each sentence. Underline the verbs.
Then diagram the sentence.

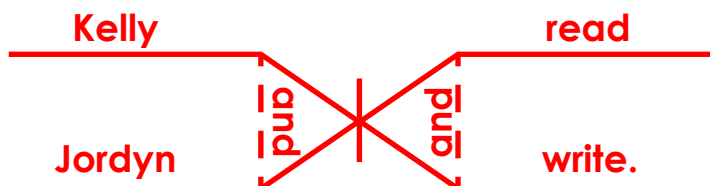
1. Oscar and Gordon dance and sing.
