Double Negatives

Negatives express the opposite of something.

Only one negative word is needed to express a negative idea.

When two negative words are used to express the same idea in a sentence, it is called a **double negative**.

Double negatives should be avoided. They make ideas unclear.

Positive

I do have a cat. I do **no**

Negative Double Negative

I do **not** have a cat. I do **not** have **no** cat.
