An **adverb** is a word that describes an action verb.

An adverb can describe **how** an action happens.

example: Jason quickly read the book.
How did Jason read? *Quickly.*

An adverb can describe **when** an action happens.

example: Emma left early.
When did Emma leave? *Early.*
