Native American Headband

- 1. Print the Native American headband on card stock or heavy paper.
- 2. Cut out the three sections of headband along the dotted lines. Cut out the feathers along the dotted lines.
- 3. Glue or tape two sections of headband together, overlapping about two inches and check for size. If necessary, glue or tape the third section to the other two, again, overlapping about two inches.
- 4. Check for size by wrapping the headband around the head. Cut off excess from one end, making sure to leave an overlap of about two inches.
- 5. Design and color the headband and color the feathers.
- 6. Adjust the overlap to fit the head and tape or glue the two ends together.
- 7. Attach the feathers to the inside of the headband at the back with glue or tape.
