“What’s going to happen to all those people? Will they be okay?” Sara asked.

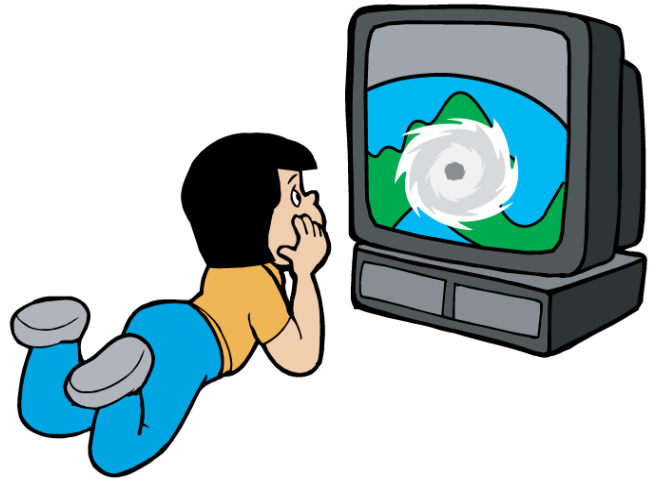
“Usually when there’s a big storm like this, people raise money and send food and other supplies to the families who lost their homes. Some people even volunteer to help rebuild houses.”

Her mother smiled. “That’s a great way to help.”



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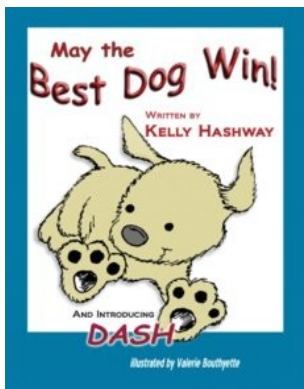

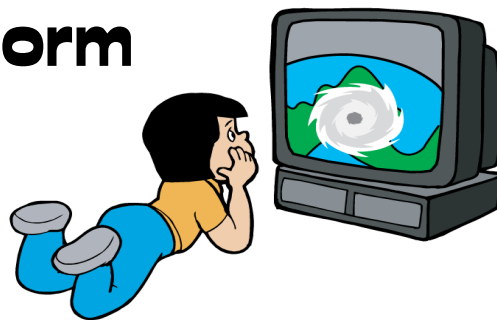
