

To the Moon

Space Trivia Board Game

Materials:

- game board (pages 2-3)
- space trivia question cards (pages 4-7)
- 6-sided die
- markers (any small object)

Preparation Tips:

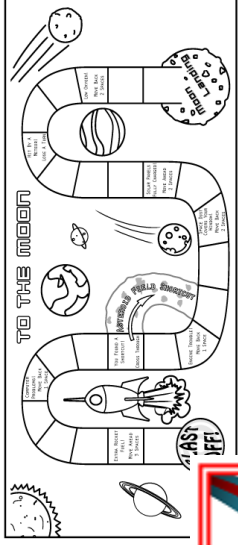
- Print the question cards on card

How to Play:

Begin by setting the markers on the board. Each player rolls the die to determine their starting square number is Player 1. The player with the highest number is Player 1. Player 1 rolls the die and moves their marker the number of squares with directions, follow the directions. Player 2 takes a question card and asks the question. If Player 1 is correct, they move forward one square. If Player 1 is incorrect, they must go back to the square they started on. Then it is Player 2's turn to roll the die and ask a question. Continue taking turns until one player lands on the "Landing" square and correctly answers the question.

Remember:

A player can only cross the asterisk square once. If a player lands on "Lose a turn," they skip their next turn.
