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## Supplementary Angles

When the measurements of two angles are added together and the sum equals $180^{\circ}$, they are called supplementary angles.
example:

$\angle \mathrm{A}=120^{\circ}$
$\angle B=60^{\circ}$
$120^{\circ}+60^{\circ}=180^{\circ}$
$\angle A$ and $\angle B$ are supplementary angles.
