How to play the game:

- Distribute the cards randomly to your students. Some students may get more than one card.
- Select a student to begin by reading their card aloud. (example: I have 35. Who has 4x4?)
- The student who has the card with the correct answer to the previous student's "Who Has..." question reads their card aloud. (example: I have 16. Who has 10x3?) And so on.
- Students must listen for their turn and try not to break the chain.
- When the chain circles around to the first student, the game is over.
