# Adverbs : How, When and Where

Adverbs tell **how**, **when**, or **where** an action happens.

examples:

Mr. Star **neatly** painted his house.

The adverb **neatly** describes **how** Mr. Star painted.

Beth **usually** goes to the store on Saturday.

The adverb **usually** describes **when** Beth goes to the store.
