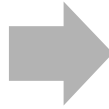

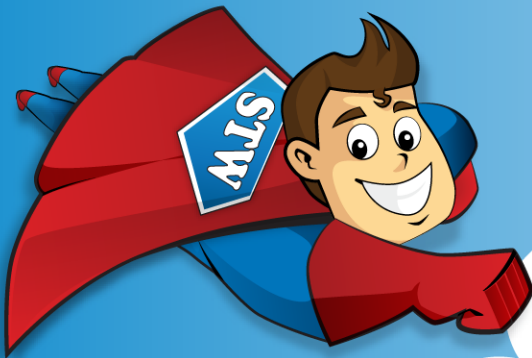
There are countless ways to use puzzle cards.  
Here are a few ideas:

## Puzzle Match

Place the puzzle pieces on the table or floor. Have small groups match up each province/territory with the correct capital.

## Find Your Partner

Give each student one puzzle piece. Half of your students will have the capitals and the other half will have the provinces/territories. Have them find their "partner" with the matching piece.



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## Find the Incorrect Match

Attach three puzzle piece pairs to a sheet of construction paper. Two matches should be correct. One should be incorrect. Laminate. Have students identify the incorrect match.

## Race to Match

Give two (or more) students a set of provinces/territories and capitals cards. Have them race to see who can correctly match all of the cards first.
