On a sunny morning, Ruby went to the fair with her parents. There were rides, games, farm animals, and food.

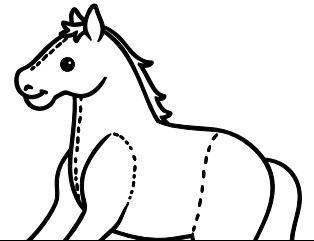
Ruby stopped at a game. The worker held up a baseball. He pointed to a can behind him. "Hit the can and get a prize."
