



Chairs with wheels have existed for millennia. Wheelchairs, however, are newer developments. The first ones appeared in China around 525 C.E. and needed aides. The first self-propelled wheelchair wasn't invented until 1655. Today, there are wheelchairs to fit many needs and budgets.

Most wheelchairs are both manual and self-propelled. Some fold for easy transport. Others are rigid, but they tend to be lighter and easier to move.

Another option is powered wheelchairs. They use batteries, motors, and controls like joysticks to operate. They're often more expensive.
