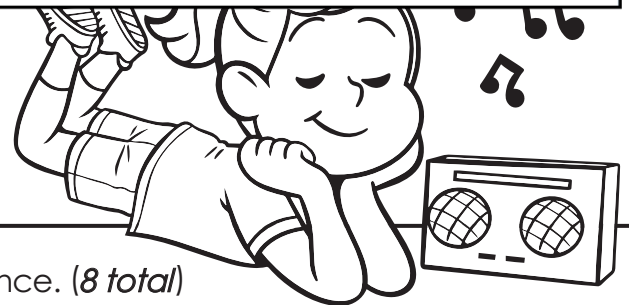

How grand is Arizona's Grand Canyon? The six-million-year-old scar in the Sonoran and Mojave Deserts is pretty spectacular. It stretches 277 miles (446 km). It reaches a max of 6,093 feet (1,857 m) deep and 18 miles (29 km) wide. You can stare at the colorful, layered landscape for hours. It's nearly two billion years of geologic history laid bare by the Colorado River.

However, the Grand Canyon is neither the longest, deepest, nor widest canyon you can visit. There are several that beat it in one way or another. Length and depth records belong to the Yarlung Tsangpo Grand Canyon in Tibet. It's about 36 miles (58 km) longer and its max depth is a jaw-dropping 19,714 feet (6,009 m). As for width, Australia's beautiful Capertee Valley squeaks past Arizona's Grand Canyon by about 1 mile (1.6 km).
