## Daily Word Problem

answer: 18 pizzas

Show your work.

$$12 + 10 = 22$$

$$1 + 2 = 3$$

$$22 - 3 = 19$$

answer: 19 cookies

**All Cost \$45 off**

What is the price of the blue jacket?

Show your work.

$$84 - 45 = 39$$

answer: \$39



Oscar has a dime, a nickel, and a penny.  
Isaac has 2 quarters, a nickel, and three pennies.  
How much more money does Isaac have than Oscar?

Show your work.

$$10 + 5 + 1 = 16$$

$$25 + 25 + 5 + 1 + 1 + 1 = 58$$

$$58 - 16 = 42$$

answer: 42¢
