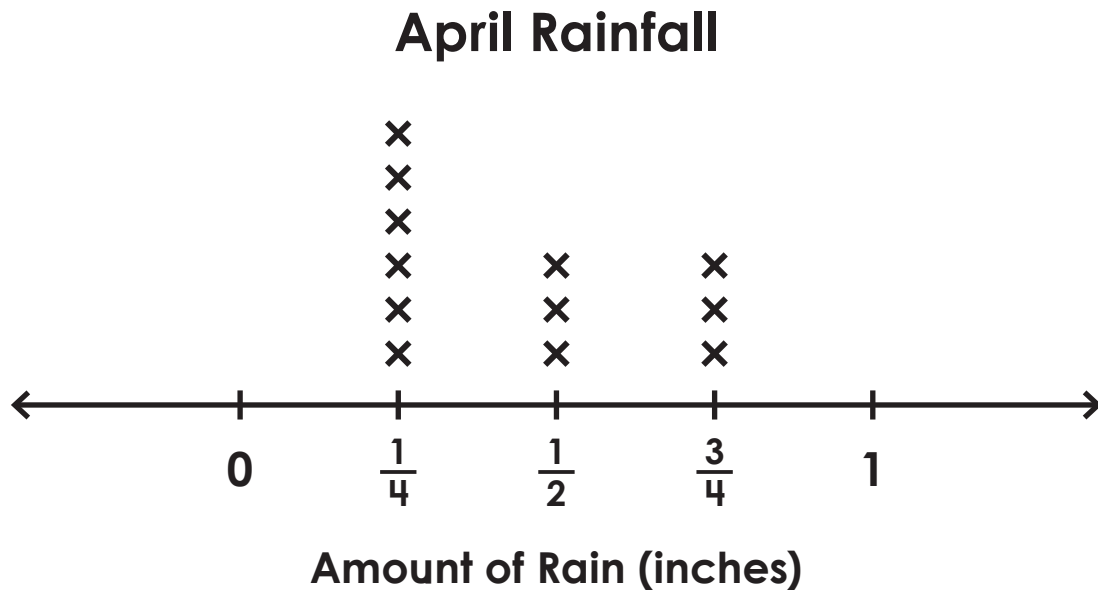

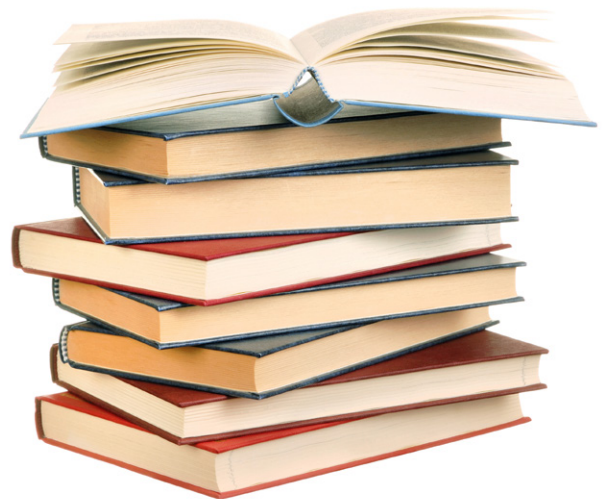

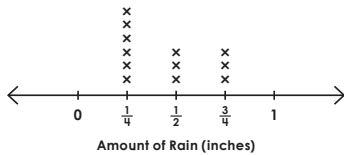

Daily Word Problem

Maylia used a line plot to record the amount of rain that fell in her town during April.

April Rainfall



What is the total amount of rain that fell in April?

Show your work:

$$\frac{1}{4} \times 6 = 1\frac{1}{2}$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \times 3 = 1\frac{1}{2}$$

$$\frac{3}{4} \times 3 = 2\frac{1}{4}$$

$$1\frac{1}{2} + 1\frac{1}{2} + 2\frac{1}{4} = 5\frac{1}{4}$$

answer: $5\frac{1}{4}$ inches



Nelson makes a total of 160 ounces of lemonade. He pours the lemonade into 12-ounce bottles until each bottle is full. How many full bottles can Nelson fill?

Show your work:

$$160 \div 12 = 13 \text{ r}4$$

answer: 13 full bottles



Mr. Najim has a square garden with a perimeter of 16.4 meters. What is the width of the garden?

Show your work:

$$16.4 \div 4 = 4.1$$

answer: 4.1 meters



A charity raised a total of \$1,648 to purchase new books for local libraries. The money raised will be shared equally among 8 different libraries. What is the total amount of money each library will receive?

Show your work:

$$1,648 \div 8 = 206$$

answer: \$206



Mrs. Lewis uses 3 sticks of butter to make cupcakes and frosting. One stick of butter equals $\frac{1}{2}$ cup. How many cups of butter does Mrs. Lewis use?

Show your work:

$$3 \times \frac{1}{2} = 1\frac{1}{2}$$

answer: $1\frac{1}{2}$ cups
