How to play the game:

- Distribute the cards randomly to your students. Some students may get more than one card.
- Select a student to begin by reading their card aloud. (example: I have come. Who has look?)



• The student who has the card with the correct answer to the previous student's "Who Has..." question reads their card aloud. (example: I have look. Who has play?) And so on.

Have...Who Has... Dolch Words/ Level: PrePrimer

- Students must listen for their turn and try not to break the chain.
- When the chain circles around to the first student, the game is over.

Suggestions:

- Print out the "I Have, Who Has" flashcards on card stock and laminate them so they will last for many years to come.
- Practice the game once with your students so they understand how the game works, then see if they can "beat the timer." Set a timer for 2 minutes, 5 minutes, or any amount of time you choose.

Challenge them to finish the game before the timer goes off.







