

# Reuse: Frog Craft

Before you throw something out or put it in the recycling bin, think about whether you can reuse it. By reusing old items, you can give them a new life!

Egg cartons can be reused as jewelry or bead organizers. Plastic bottles can be reused in a number of ways, such as planters, pencil holders, or bird feeders.

Old cardboard tubes from paper towels or toilet paper can make great craft supplies. Next time you're about to throw one away, save it and make this fun frog craft!

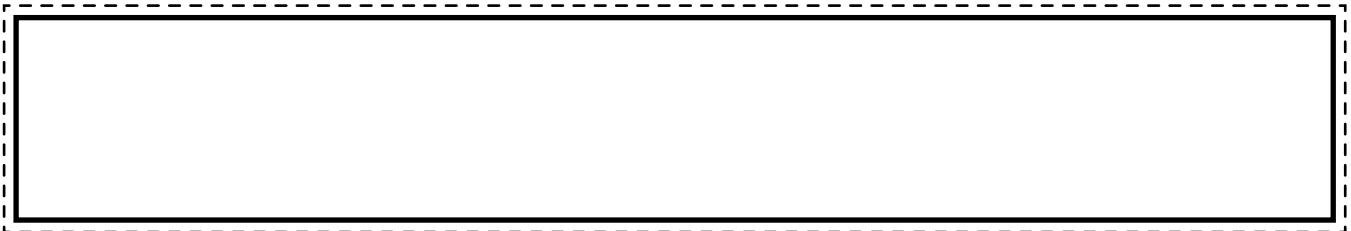

# Reuse: Frog Craft

## Materials:

- frog template (page 1 of this file)
- cardboard toilet paper tube (or paper towel tube cut to size)
- green, black, and red markers
- scissors
- tape or glue

## Directions:

1. Cut out the pieces of the frog template.



2. Fold each of the leg pieces in half to make a shorter rectangle. Tape or glue the bottom edges together, keeping the middle part open.
7. Glue or tape the feet to the bottom of the tube.
8. Glue or tape the legs to the tube, right above the feet.
9. Glue or tape the eyes above the mouth.
10. Roll the tongue around a pencil or marker to make it curl. Glue or tape it to the mouth.
