almost 10 feet thick and trunks over 60 feet in diameter. Most redwoods have bark that is 1 foot thick and trunks that are 20 feet in diameter.

Where in California do these giant trees live. Coast redwoods live along the ocean. Here, moist summer fog, winter rain, and moderate year-round temperatures provide the perfect weather. The Northern California coast, a small piece of southern Oregon, and Muir Woods near San Francisco are such places. Sequoias do not live near the ocean. Instead, they live on the western slopes of California's Sierra Nevada mountains. It is drier and warmer here. Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks feature the largest and most numerous sequoia groves. Sequoias also grow in a portion of Yosemite National Park, and in the Sequoia National Forest.
