Grammar Garden Activity

Objective: This activity will give students the opportunity to use parts of speech in a

creative context.

Materials: Parts of Speech Table and Grammar Garden picture, included.

Directions: Provide a copy of the Parts of Speech Table and Grammar Garden picture

to each student. Decide how many words in each part of speech category students will need to fill in on their table. (We recommend three words for each part of speech.) Students will label their Grammar Garden picture with words of their own choosing from each category. The students will then write the


words they chose under the correct category on their table.

example: The student must choose three nouns that he sees in the Grammar Garden picture.

He chooses flower, rabbit, and gardener.

The student labels the Grammar Garden picture with those words and adds them to the "Nouns" box in his Parts of Speech Table.

He does the same with three pronouns, adjectives, and verbs.



Note: Students can choose whichever words they would like, as long as the part of speech is being used correctly and sorted into the right category on the table. The teacher will assess the student's Part of Speech Table accordingly.
