## Bar Graphs vs. Histograms


Although they look similar, bar graphs and histograms have different features and display different types of data.





## • mostly display categorical data

- have gaps between bars
- can have a dependent variable other than frequency

### • only display numerical data

- bars, called bins, show continuous, equal, nonoverlapping intervals
- do not have gaps between bins
- only use frequency or relative frequency as the dependent variable
