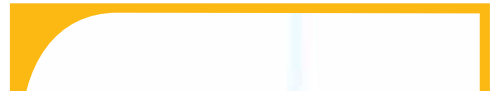
Cut the cards on the dotted lines.

How to play:

Mix up the cards and lay them all upside-down on the table in a grid pattern. Players will try to flip pairs of cards with the same picture.

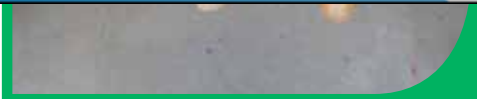
Player 1 flips two cards. If the cards match, he or she gets to keep both cards. If the cards do not match, then the cards are flipped back upside-down.

Then player 2 gets a turn to try to flip matching cards. Players alternate until all cards have been removed from the game. When the game is over, the player with the most cards is the winner.

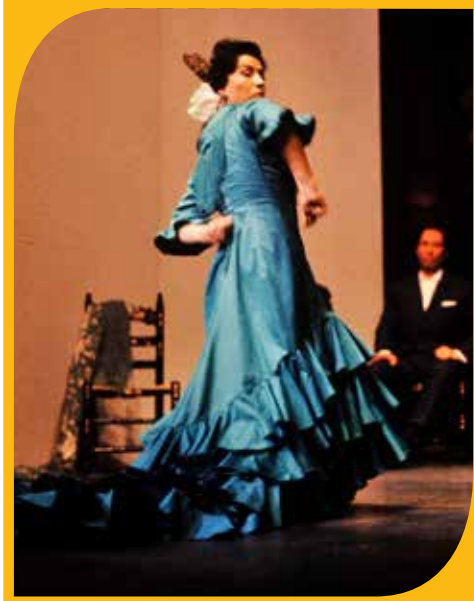
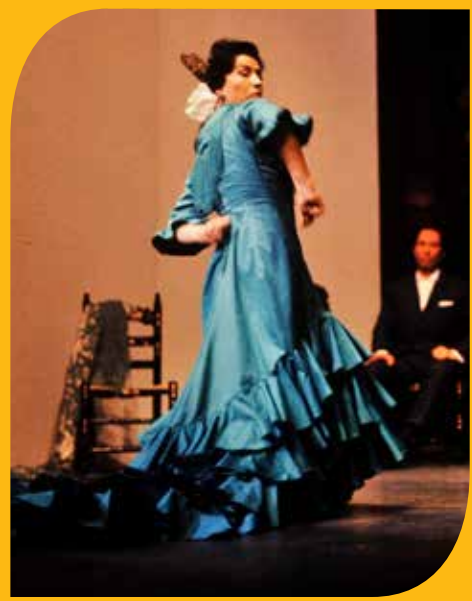
