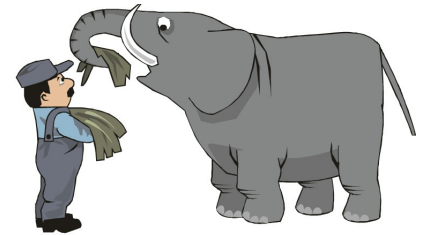


What Is My Occupation?

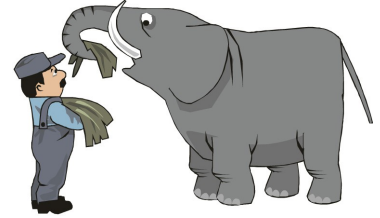
