Multiplying and Dividing Integers

Rules: If the signs of the two integers are the **same**, the product/quotient is **positive**.

If the signs of the two integers are **different**, the product/quotient is **negative**.

a. $-7 \times \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = -56$
