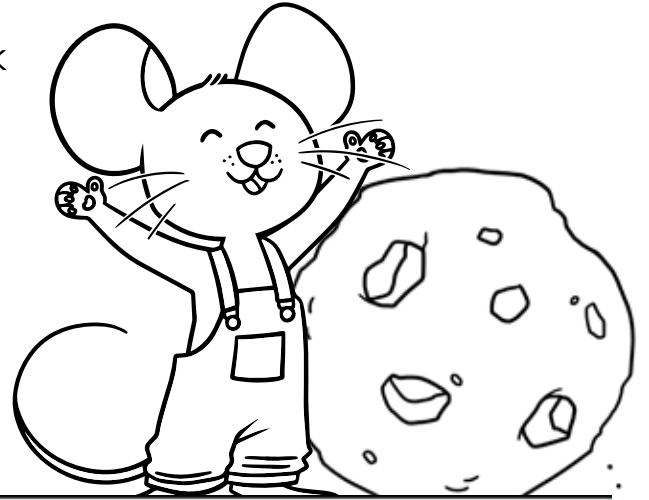
## Materials:

You may want to call on students randomly to ensure that all students are comprehending.

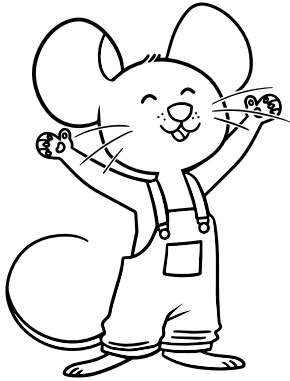
