Pronouns and Antecedents

Pronouns need to agree with their antecedents in number and person.

Use a singular pronoun for a singular antecedent.

singular antecedent **singular pronoun**
↓ ↓
example: Miley has her first dance performance on Sunday.

Use a plural pronoun for a plural antecedent.

plural antecedent **plural pronoun**
↓ ↓
example: The dancers are getting ready in their dressing room.
