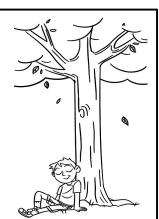
Use quotation marks around the exact words someone says when they are speaking.

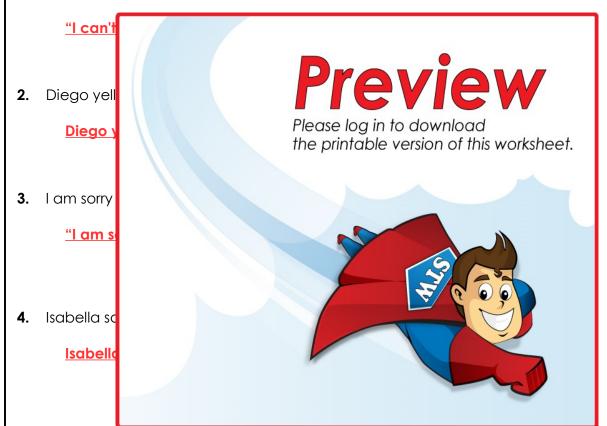
