## **Amelia Earhart**

Amelia Earhart (1897 – 1937) was a pioneer in American aviation. She was the first female aviator to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean. Earhart set many records in early aviation history and wrote best-selling books about her experiences as an aviator.

Earhart was born in Atchison, Kansas on July 24, 1897. She was an adventurous child. As a young adult, Earhart was fascinated by flying and gained a lot of flying experience throughout her twenties. In 1928, Earhart became the first female airplane passenger to fly over the Atlantic Ocean. She became a celebrity for this act of courage. Then in 1932, Earhart became the first woman to fly across the Atlantic Ocean solo. She was awarded the United States Distinguished Flying Cross.
