The goddess of marriage and family was also queen of the gods on Mount Olympus. Hera is associated with motherly and elegant symbols like cows, peacocks, crowns, and scepters.

Hera was one of six children of the titans Cronus and Rhea. Although she was Zeus's sister and wife, their relationship was tumultuous; she took a jealous, vengeful approach to his many lovers and children. Perhaps that's where Ares—god of war and one of her sons—got his temper.
