"Go to sleep," Dad told Ian. "It's past your bedtime."

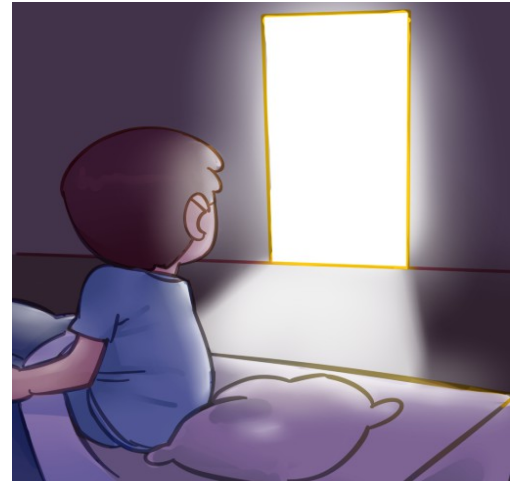
Ian went upstairs to his bedroom and climbed into bed. He was lying in bed and trying to sleep.

Sir Wags-a-Lot barked.

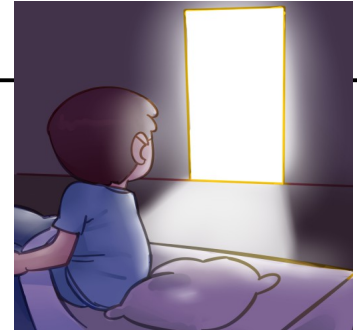
Ian patted his dog. "Go to sleep, boy."

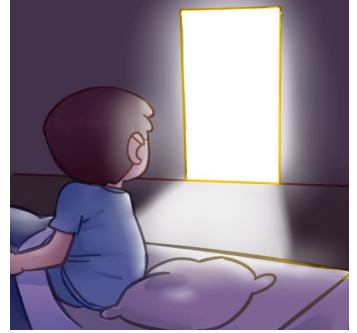

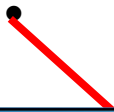
