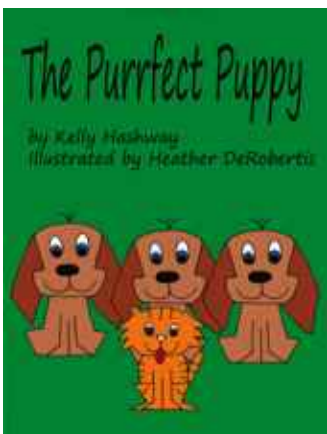

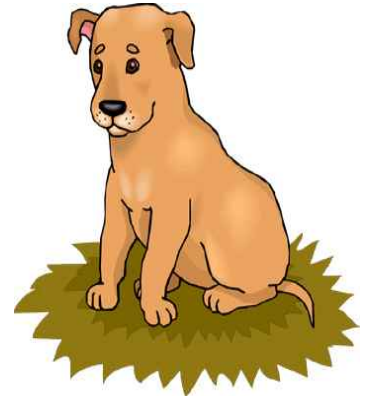

Think of some things that full-grown dogs can do that puppies cannot do. Write a paragraph in which you describe some of the ways a puppy changes as it grows up.



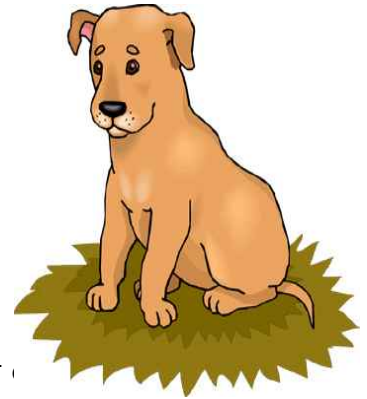
