## About Your Spelling Words

When a vowel is followed by the letter $r$, it makes a special sound. These are called $r$-controlled vowels. Some examples include:

- /ar/ sound as in car, artist, and Mars
- /ər/ sound as in butter, earth, and hurt
- /or/ sound as in cord, orchard, and more

The /ər/ sound can be spelled with the letters er (like mother), ir (like bird), or ur (fur).
