"To the playground!" said Dad. "A little rain won't hurt us!"

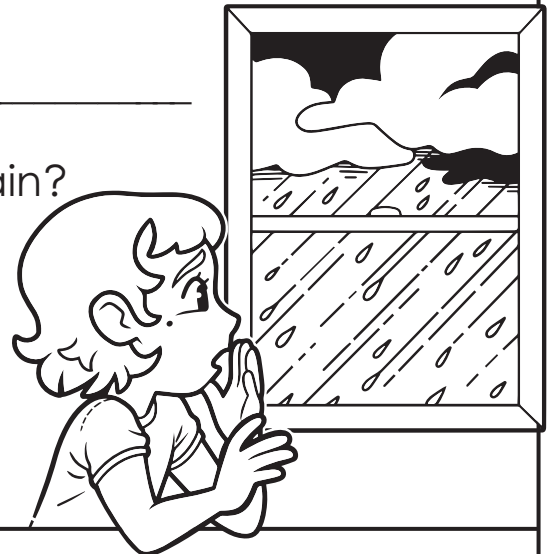

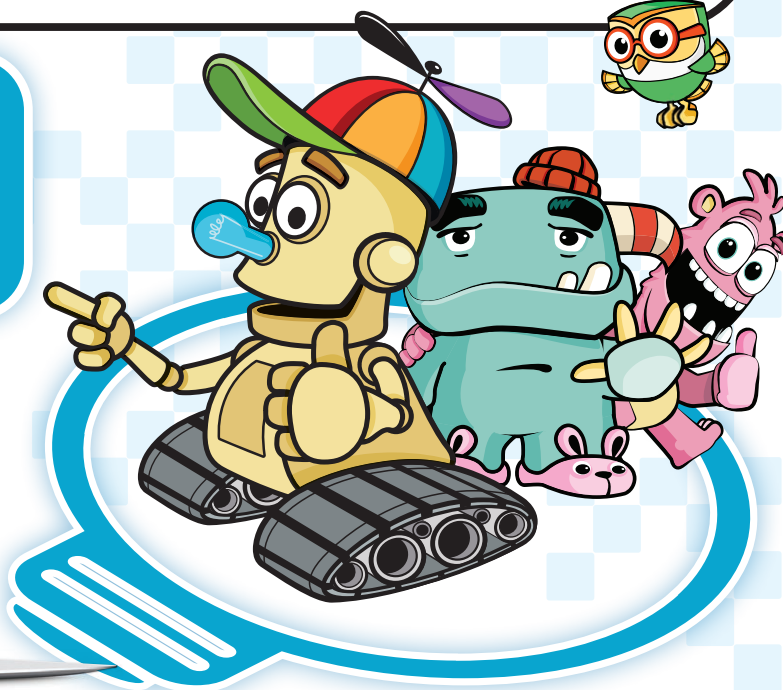
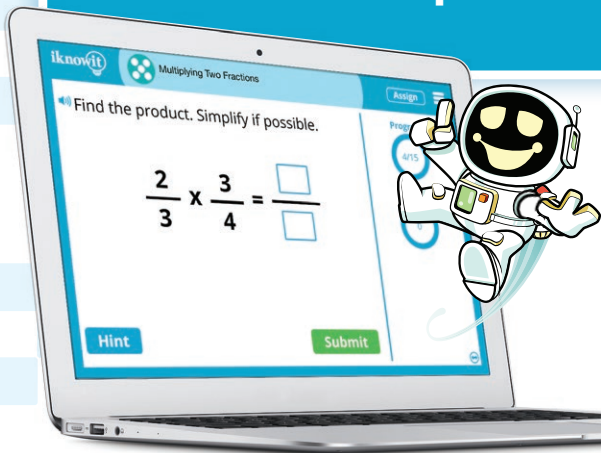
