Each ant colony has a queen ant who lays eggs. Worker ants find food and clean the nest. Soldier ants keep the colony safe.

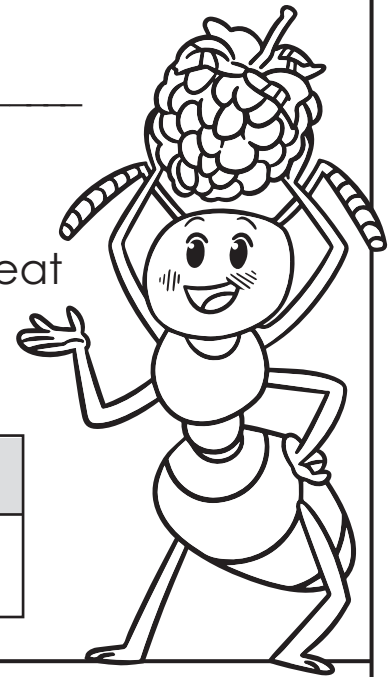
