## Summer Buzz

Think of Earth like a ball. Now think of a stick going through it from top to bottom. Spin the stick between your fingers. The ball spins.

Earth rotates just like that. When where you live faces the sun, it's day. When it faces away, it's night.

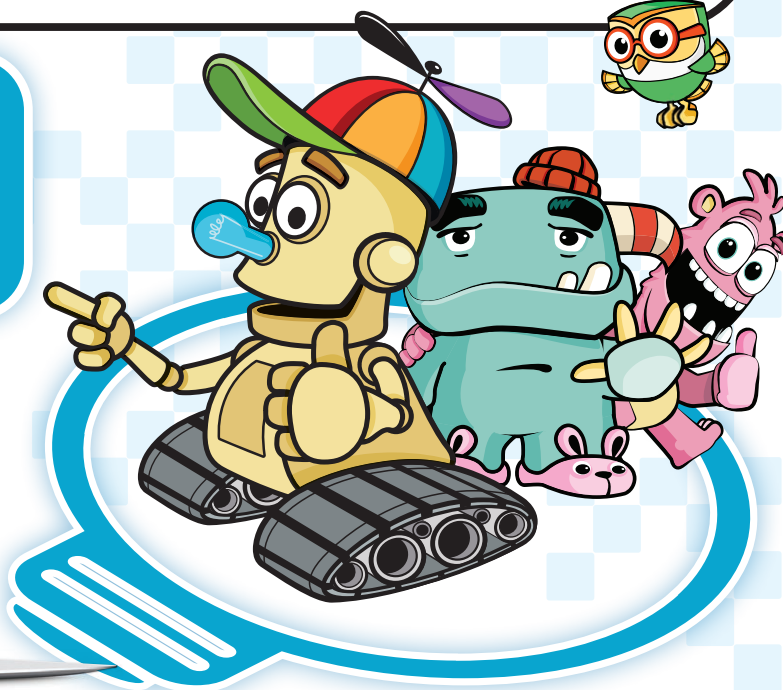
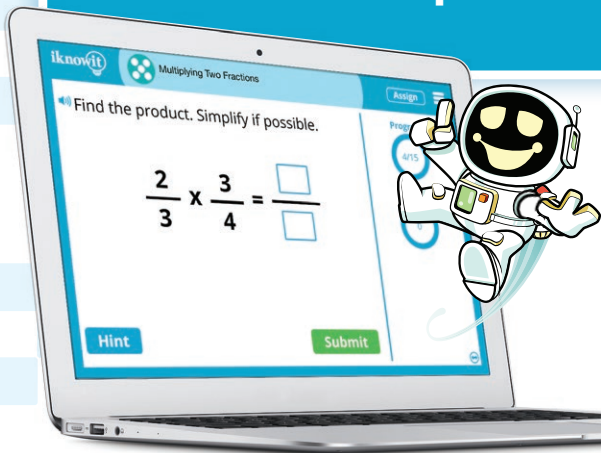
