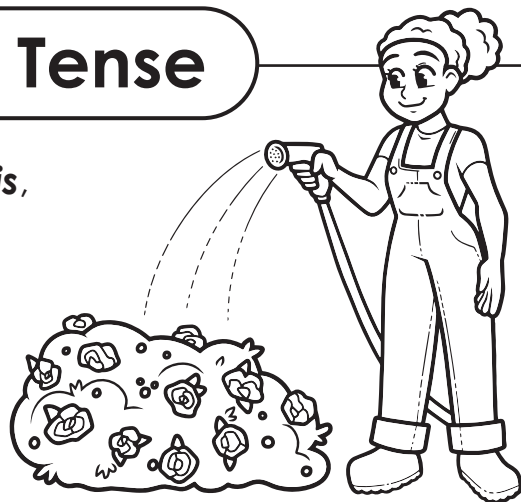

Complete the sentences using the correct form of **be**.



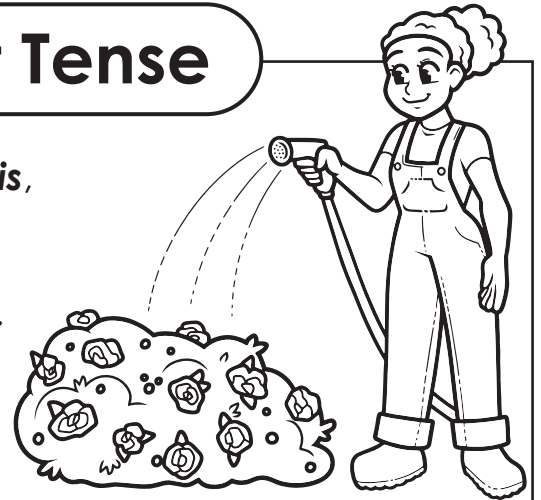
